



## North Olmsted 6th Grade Electives Course Catalog 2024-2025

All incoming 6<sup>th</sup> graders will automatically be enrolled in an elective wheel that includes art, health, computers, and technology education. They then have the option to choose **two of the four electives listed below**. All students MUST take some form of music (band, orchestra, or choir). This can be paired with either a second music elective or physical education.

BAND (Full Year) – This class is open to all NOMS students without audition. Students are responsible for providing their own instrument and will need to purchase a book. There will be 2 evening concerts throughout the year and an opportunity to compete at the OMEA contest. Required concert attire is black dress pants, black dress shoes, and a white long sleeve button down dress shirt. Band instruments include flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, and percussion.

ORCHESTRA (Full Year) - This class is open to all NOMS students without audition. Students are responsible for providing their own instrument and will need to purchase a book. There will be 2 evening concerts throughout the year and an opportunity to compete at the OMEA contest. Required concert attire is black dress pants, black dress shoes, and a white long sleeve button down dress shirt. Orchestra instruments include violin, viola, cello, and string bass.

CHOIR (Full Year) – This class is open to all NOMS students without audition. The focus of choir is to be a family of singing, exploring many fun styles of music from classical to barbershop harmony and novelty numbers. Members will learn the basics of vocal technique and sight-reading in order to become functional, confident singers. Concert Choir performs at NOMS concerts and will hope to compete at OMEA large group contest. Required concert attire is black dress pants, black dress shoes, and a white long sleeve button down dress shirt.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (Full Year) – PE is designed to provide students with the necessary skills to participate in various team and individual sports. Students will learn rules, terminology, skills, and strategies used to actively participate in these sports. A major focus of the class is on personal and lifelong fitness. Students will learn, through multiple activities, how to maintain an active, healthy lifestyle. A PE uniform must be purchased and students are required to wear tennis shoes.
