Using Google Meet to Connect

Be Responsible

- Check your technology before the meeting begins.
- Be on time: Log on a few minutes before the meet begins.
- Pick a quiet spot and let others around know you are in a meeting.
- Look around you. Make sure anything on video is something that can be seen by others.
- Do your best to correct grammar and spelling in the chat box to ask questions and share ideas.
- Use headphones if you have them.



Be Respectful



- Ask questions about what you are learning or discussing.
- Be kind and respectful to others.
- Nod or give a thumbs up to show you understand.
- Mute your microphone unless you are talking.
- Wear clothes that would be appropriate for school.
- Pause your video if you have to step away from your computer.

Be Safe

- Use your n olmsted (North Olmsted) log on.
- Protect your password by not sharing it with others.
- Protect your class code by not sharing it with others.
- Participate in class meetings only if you are invited. No one else should be on camera unless your teacher says it is okay.
- Follow school rules for using computers.

Do not take photos or screenshots or record videos during the meeting.
